Discipline Guidelines



1. Player Red Carding (send off):

- A player who receives a red card as a result of 2 yellow cards is suspended for the remainder of the current game plus 1 additional game.
- A player who receives a straight red card is suspended for the remainder of the current game plus 2 additional games.
- A player who receives a flagrant red card (throwing punches, causing injury) is suspended the remainder of the current game plus 2 games and possibility up to 4 game (based on decision of the Discipline Committee)
- Any player with multiple red cards in a calendar year could be subject to up to doubling to the initial red card suspension based on the decision of the Discipline Committee.

2. Coach Red Carding:

- Any coach who receives a red card as a result of 2 yellow cards is suspended for the remainder of the current game plus 1 additional game.
- Any coach who receives a straight red or is removed from the field at any time by the referee is suspended for the remainder of the current game plus 2 additional games.
- Any coach who receives 2 red cards during a calendar year will be suspended for 8 games.
- Any coach who receives 3 or more red cards during their time coaching in the OHTSL will be permanently suspended from the league.

3. Spectator Removed from Game:

- Any spectator removed from a game by a referee will be referred back to the community for handling. The community will be required to report back to the league the handling of the issue. The league does reserve the right based on the incident to apply additional suspension if it feels necessary.
