2. President Report - Howard:

- Effective this fall the GAASA has merged with OHTSL
- OHTSL will start a high school division in the spring similar to what GAASA offered
- No changes for player fees for this year from US Club Soccer
- No changes for referee fees
- No change for team fees
- Goal of the board is to get community involvement in decisions

3. Treasurer Report - Howard:

- \$480,000 balance, down from prior years, expect continued reduction in balance due to increase in neutral site games which OHTSL covers the neutral site field fees
- 14 communities still need to submit spring registration fees
- Budget: \$388,000 in revenue and \$388,000 in expenses for 2022
 - Largest expenses = staff & tournaments
