2. President's Report: (Chris)

- 2024 Board Elections
 - Introduce Dave who took a vacant board position from the fall
 - Three positions are up for election
 - 2-3 board members seeking another term
 - Emails will go out to all the communities, if anyone wants to talk about it feel free to come talk to me after the meeting
- o Fees:
 - Player pass rates will increase by \$2 per pass for the fall 2024 to spring 2025 season.

3. General Info/Technology Update: (Joey)

- <u>Community Maintenance</u> Please ensure your community contacts & fields are updated/accurate, including the newly added fields for Treasure & DOC contact
- <u>Location Maintenance</u> Please ensure your locations & fields are updated & active BEFORE game scheduling on 3/20.
- <u>Team Codes</u> Community Reps are now able to edit their teams codes by accessing League->Edit Team
 Code. Select the CB next to the team you wish to edit, edit the 4 digit team code & select "Update".
- Field Black Out Dates Community Reps may enter black out dates per field. Select your field (or select All Fields), select the date and click "Add". To remove a date select the date and click "Delete"
 - No team black out dates
- Neutral Site Payment Request Form has be updated from a paper form to google form
- Game Score Reporting game scores are required to be reported by both teams within 24 hours of the game. To mitigate some issues with some coaches not entering scores by the deadline there will be an email notification sent to the coach 48 hours post game if a score has not been entered and then at 72 hours the game score entry will be locked and results will be defaulted to the score entered by the opposing team or 0-0 if neither team enters scores. 4. Policy/Procedure Updates: (Chris)

- Effective immediately/Spring 2024:
 - Game Check-in Non-Compliance must be filled out within 24 hours of the game
 - Game Change Policy Update: (<u>Procedures ->Game Scheduling Information</u>)
 - Update the game change policy from 7 days to 5 days in the game change system.
 - Eliminate the manual email process for requests made 3-5 days prior
 - If less than 5 days no game change will be accepted, if the game is unable to be played on the original date/time then the team that is not available will forfeit the game (score of 0-5 loss) and will be required to pay the referee (TBD base on game size see ref fees on website) and the ref assignor fees (\$10). There will no longer be a \$100 forfeit fee.
 - Exceptions: game canceled due to weather related field closure or school sports events rescheduled (may require proof school reschedule) within the 5 days.
 - Each team can only initiate 3 game changes after the schedule has been posted.
 - Neutral Game Site Locations Requests (minor change in the order of steps & contact)
 - During the "Preliminary Game Scheduling" process a Community Rep contacts admin@ohtsl.com to request a neutral site location.
 - OHTSL Administrator will identify a neutral site location, update the game scheduling system with the new location and notify both Community Reps.
 - Both reps work together to agree on a game date/time (using the game change scheduling system).
 - OHTSL will compensate the community hosting the Neutral Site game (\$35.00).
 - The home team still pays the referee fee.
- Just FYI.... Effective Fall 2024:

- Bracketing any community with multiple teams exceeding the OHTSL max size roster in the same age bracket must play in consecutive divisions (not D1 & D3)teams, must be D1 & D2 or D2 & D3 if the roster exceeds the roster max).
- Guest Player/Double Rostering no player is permitted to play lower than 2 divisions below their highest rostered division within the players age bracket (ie. if a player is rostered D1 they may not play in D4 or lower). The penalty if a player is caught playing more than 2 divisions lower is forfeit of the game & 4 game suspension for every coach registered to the team.
- Out of Community Players removal of the exception regarding communities who do not have age appropriate teams. All out of community players will count in the 3 player limit. Any team found out of compliance with the three player rule will not be eligible for trophy reimbursement.
